Dear Mr. Ambassador,

with reference to the letter of the Minister of Infrastructure and Regional Development of Moldova of February 25, 2022 and note No. POL/102.2/100 of February 26, 2022 on providing assistance in solving the problem of the impossibility of returning Moldovan heavy goods vehicles from Russia and consequently, the necessity to return to Moldova via Poland, Slovakia, Hungary and Romania, I would like to kindly inform you about the support provided by Poland.

The Ministry of Infrastructure applied to the National Revenue Administration, Border Guard and the Chief Inspectorate of Road Transport with a request to take into account, in the course of inspections, the scans of foreign permits for international road transport of goods provided by the National Road Transport Agency (ANTA) of Moldova, so as to enable Moldovan road hauliers to return to Moldova, through the territory of Poland.

The actions taken meet the request contained in the above-mentioned correspondence and a proposal submitted by the Embassy of Moldova to use the authorizations held by the ANTA by sending their scans to Moldovan carriers in accordance with the list attached to the above-mentioned a note that was forwarded to the Polish inspection services along with a letter to honor this form of documents in the current extraordinary situation.
